



## Get Their Attention!

Materials: Penguin Stamper

**PLAY** the “Clean Up Song” (See “Environmental Music” Document in “Music” Folder) & have kids gather on the floor.

**SIT/KNEEL** with kids & tell them your name.

**WELCOME** kids to the chilly willy Arctic! **EXPLAIN** that in the land of ice and snow we will see cool animals, hear amazing stories from the Bible & learn how to love God with our words!

**INTRODUCE** each child to the group as you give each child a **Penguin Stamp** and **SAY**:

**(Child's name), welcome to the Arctic!**

**AFTER** all kids have been introduced, **SAY** & **DO** the following:

**In the Arctic, it gets really cold! To keep from freezing, penguins** (hold up **Stamped** hand) **like to waddle and play in the snow. Would you have fun playing in the snow, too?** (Allow responses.)

**Okay then, let's stand up and waddle like penguins!** (Demonstrate how to waddle and have kids stand up and waddle.)

**Peppy Penguin wants to help us practice saying “I’m sorry” if we do something wrong, like if we bump into each other as we waddle around.**

**If you can say “I’m sorry,” repeat this after me:**

**I Can Say,** (thumbs to chest)

**“I’m Sorry!”** (move fist in circle on chest)

### Bible Story:

#### Jonah and the Big Fish

Jonah 1:1-3:10

### Need to Know:

**I Can Say,**

(thumbs to chest)

**“I’m Sorry!”**

(move fist in circle on chest)

### Materials:

- ✳ **Bible Story Picture Cards**
- ✳ **Coloring Sheets**
- ✳ **Crayons**
- ✳ **Filler Guide**

### Review Questions:

Use these questions to review what kids have learned as they eat and color.

- ✳ **In the Bible Story today, did Jonah obey what God told him to do or did he run away?** (Ran away)
- ✳ **When Jonah was in the fish's belly, did he tell God “It's stinky” or “Please forgive me?”** (Please forgive me)
- ✳ **Did you have fun today?**

## Make It Matter

Materials: Hand Sanitizer, Snacks, Bible Story Picture Cards, Coloring Sheets, Crayons, Filler Guide

Have leaders & kids hold hands as you **SAY** the following prayer:

**Dear God, we're sorry for when we do wrong things. Thank you for our snacks. We love you! Amen!**

**SANITIZE** hands with **hand sanitizer** & **PASS OUT** **snacks**.

**SHOW & READ** **Bible Story Picture Cards** (“Jonah and the Big Fish”) while kids **EAT**.

\*NOTE: Jonah is pronounced “Jone-uh.”

**GIVE** each child a **coloring sheet & crayons**.

As kids eat & color, **REVIEW** what they learned today (Need to Know, Bible Story & Large Group) using questions on left.

Use this time to ensure each child's **DIAPER** is changed or is taken to the **POTTY**.

**USE** **Filler Guide**, as needed, to review Remember Verse and to keep kids engaged.
