



Abraham Shares

Genesis 13

Abraham and his nephew Lot lived close to each other. Abraham had a lot of
(point to sheep) **sheep**, (point to cow) **cows**, (point to goat) **goats &** (point to
donkey) **donkeys. Lot did, too!**

Can you say “moo” like the cows in the field?
(Everyone says “moo”)



There were SO many animals that there wasn't enough water and grass for all of them.

Abraham's helpers and Lot's helpers started arguing with each other.

They said mean things like, (say in mad voice) "This water is OURS!" And, "This is OUR grass!"

Can you show me a mean face, like the helpers?
(Everyone makes a mean face)



Abraham didn't (shake head "no") **want his family to argue. So Abraham let Lot choose whatever land he wanted for his family and animals.**

Let's all pretend to look (make binoculars with hands) **for land like Lot** (Everyone makes binoculars with hands).



Abraham wanted his family to be HAPPY (point to smile) **and SHARE the land.**

Abraham and Lot learned they could BE HAPPY (point to smile) **WITH WHAT** (arms forward, palms up) **THEY HAD** (pull arms to sides).

When we are happy with what we have, we are showing God and others that we LOVE them!

Let me hear you say this after me:

(Pause to allow kids to repeat each line)

Be Happy (point to smile)

With What (arms forward, palms up)

You Have! (pull arms to sides)
